Macquarie Graduate School of Management Malcolm Irving Scholarship Application Form

Information

Dr Malcolm Irving has been a member of the Macquarie University Council and Chair of the university's Finance Committee since 1993. He was awarded the honorary degree of Doctor of Letters by Macquarie in 1993 in recognition of his service to the university including his major role in the development of the Macquarie Graduate School of Management.

Dr Irving holds a number of directorships and chairs covering the corporate and community service sectors including Chairman of Caltex Australia, Director of Telstra Corporation, Chairman of the Australian Industry Development Corporation and Director of the Victor Chang Cardiac Research Institute.

Dr Irving was elected unopposed as Deputy Chancellor by the Macquarie University Council on 24 March 2000.

In recognition of the contribution made by Dr Irving to the Macquarie Graduate School of Management, the School has created an annual scholarship in his name, to award an eligible candidate beginning in the June intake with a contribution of 50% of the tuition fees for a Postgraduate Diploma in Management.

Eligibility and Selection Criteria

In order to be considered for the Malcolm Irving Scholarship, the applicant:

- Must gain acceptance to the MGSM Postgraduate Diploma program
- Must be a citizen of a country other than Australia.

The Scholarship Awards Committee will consider the applicant's:

- Career achievements (as outlined in the applicant's CV, but especially those outside of positional roles)
- Personal achievements, goals and ambitions (as outlined in the applicant's Statement of Personal Aims and Achievements)
- Community activities
- Expectations and perceived value of the program to their career
- Motivation and desire to achieve in a program
- Scholastic achievements (as outlined in the applicant's program application form)
- Leadership roles

Application Procedure

All scholarship applications should be submitted, along with the candidate's MGSM Program application, before the relevant application closing date. Please refer to the MGSM Scholarships Policy for the application closing dates.
