Information

The Vice Chancellor of Macquarie University has created a scholarship to award an eligible candidate beginning their studies in January or June intake with a contribution of 50% of the tuition fees for an MBA.

Eligibility and Selection Criteria

In order to be considered for the Vice Chancellor's Scholarship, the applicant:

- Must gain acceptance to the MGSM MBA program
- Must be a citizen of a country other than Australia.

The Scholarship Awards Committee will consider the applicant's:

- Career achievements (as outlined in the applicant's CV)
- Personal achievements, goals and ambitions (as outlined in the applicant's Statement of Personal Aims and Achievements)
- Community activities
- Expectations and perceived value of the program to their career
- Motivation and desire to achieve in a program
- Scholastic achievements (as outlined in the applicant's program application form)
- Leadership roles

Application Procedure

All scholarship applications should be submitted, along with the candidate's MGSM Program application, before the relevant application closing date. Please refer to the MGSM Scholarships Policy for the application closing dates.
